



5th Grade Schools Supplies List

Please separate supplies needed for Kodesh Studies and General Studies in 2 bags

General School Supply List that *every* student needs:

- Labeled reusable water bottle
- 2 boxes of sharpened yellow #2 pencils (at least 24 total)
- 1 small manual sharpener with a lid to catch shavings
- 4 white polymer erasers
- 1 small bottle of Elmer's Glue
- Thin markers, pack of 12
- 1 box of crayons
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 2 primary composition notebooks, different colors
- 2 sets of family pictures

KODESH (Girls):

- Sheet protectors
- 2 packs lined paper
- 5 highlighters (at least 3 colors, including yellow)
- 6 folders
- 2 composition notebooks
- Colored pens
- Blue and black pens
- Scissors
- 2 Glue stick
- Markers
- Pencil case (to hold all pencils, markers, etc)
- Container of Wipes
- 1 inch binder
- Index cards
- Small dry erase board
- Dry erase markers

KODESH (Boys):

- Green Tehilas Hashem Siddur with numbered lines
- Tehillim
- 2 1.5-inch binders
- 4 folders
- 2 composition books
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Red, yellow, green, blue highlighters (These specific four colors are needed)
- Lined index cards
- Index card holder



Stuff I Need for Mr. Lefrak's Class

- **A spiral notebook with lined paper** (with perforations for easy removal of sheets) Mark this notebook "math".
- **A Pocket folder (laminated)** Get the laminated paper one, not regular paperboard or plastic. Laminated paper ones last the longest and things don't slip out of them. Mark this folder "Homework Folder".
- **A TWO-INCH D-ring binder.** Please be sure it is a D-ring, not a regular O-ring. D-rings hold more sheets, cause less jamming and are generally made better. This is the one item you'd rather spend a couple of extra bucks on and get the better version. It'll save your child from a lot of headaches later on.
- **A package of tabbed dividers, 8-tab.** Please get the ones that are not see-through plastic. The tabs themselves can be the pocket ones or the flat ones on which you place stickers. I will be providing the stickers themselves.
- **A package of pencils (#2 type).** If you can find them, Ticonderoga is the best company to use. Other companies break or don't sharpen well.
- **Two highlighters (any color)** Yellow tends easiest to read with.
- **An eraser**
- **A sharpener**
- **A Pencil box,** big enough to hold all the above four items.
- **A plastic index card case** for 3.5" x 5" index cards. The box itself should be about an inch or two thick. Bigger than that will just take up space and be difficult to store.
- **A shelving system for a locker.** It'll help double the space in the locker we are providing. Just be sure it is sturdy and adjustable.

I will be supplying rulers, scissors, tape and glue, as necessary.

There is no need to buy those items.

Please be sure your child's name is on everything you can put it on.
